

## **RADLEY PARISH COUNCIL**

### **DOGS IN THE GROUND**

Byelaws made by the Parish Council of Radley under section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 with respect of public walks and pleasure grounds.

#### **EXTENT**

1. (1) These byelaws apply to the public walks and pleasure grounds named in the schedule and hereafter referred to as "the grounds".
- (2) Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given by signs placed in conspicuous positions in or near each of the grounds.

#### **INTERPRETATION**

2. (1) In these byelaws:  
"the Council" means the Parish Council of Radley
- (2) For the purpose of these byelaws the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless that at the time when the dog entered or remained in the grounds it had been placed or taken into the charge of some other person.
- (3) In paragraph (2) above "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

### **DOGS IN THE GROUNDS**

3. (1) No person in charge of a dog, (other than a registered blind person) shall, without reasonable excuse, permit the dog to enter or remain in the grounds.
- (2) An officer of the Council or any constable may require a person in charge of a dog which has entered the grounds to remove the dog from the grounds.

#### **REMOVAL**

4. Any person offending against these byelaws may be removed from the grounds by any officer of the Council or any constable.

#### **PENALTY**

5. Any person offending against byelaw 3 shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
