We are delighted to share the Youths' and Children's categories for Radley Flower Show 2022 (Saturday 25th June):

Youths' Categories

These are aimed at secondary school age children, however, younger children are welcome to enter these classes as well as teenagers up to the age of 18.

- **“Jubilee” cupcakes** – iced/decorated cupcakes for a Jubilee celebration party.
- **A plant grown from seed, a seedling or a cutting** grown in a **home-made plant pot** made from **recycled materials**.
- **Bug hotel** – natural materials (no plastic).
- **A portrait of any English or British queen** **Andy Warhol/pop art style**, maximum size A3.
- **A colour photograph** on the theme **“Favourite Pet”**.

Children's Categories

These are open to very young and primary school age children only.

- **Animal** – made using **fruit** and/or **vegetables**.
- **Cress grown in a decorated egg shell**.
- **Decorated rich tea biscuits with a “Crown Jewels” theme**. These will be judged on decoration only and shop bought biscuits may be used.
- **Picture of a royal palace or castle**, maximum size A4.
- **Jubilee coin or medal** – design and make a coin/medal, any size, any material.

We hope these will give children and teenagers some ideas for fun and creative activities to do and that they will be inspired to try to win one of the awards for young people:

- **The Ann Blake Youth Award** – awarded to the young person aged 11 to 18 who has participated in all the categories in the youths' section and/or gained the most points.
- **The Walter Long Children's Cup** – awarded to the child gaining most points in the children's section.
- **The Radley Family Primary Cup** – awarded to the family with the most points and with at least one child attending Radley Primary School or Foundation Stage Unit.

This year, Mrs Thomas, the headteacher of Radley Primary School, will present the Radley Primary School Cup to the winner.

The theme of this year's Radley Flower Show is the Queen's Platinum Jubilee and during the afternoon of the show there will be some entertainment. This will include a children's crown parade: children will make a crown at home, bring it to the show (no need to apply to enter in advance) and then parade to music wearing it - the best crown will win a small prize.
