Here is the latest neighbourhood policing update from PCSO Zack Earl.

### Offenders brought to justice

We received a report from a member of staff from the Kennington Community Centre that criminal damage has been caused to the male toilets. After investigating this incident we issued two young people with Youth Restorative disposal (YRD) for causing criminal damage to the Kennington Community Centre.

### Anti-social behaviour (ASB)

There has been on-going issues around the community centre in Kennington. We have increased our patrols in this area and if you witness any anti-social behaviour please call the police non-emergency number 101. We will continue to monitor the situation.

### Crime prevention advice

We have had an increase of vehicles are being stolen from outside properties because people are leaving their keys in them while they wait for their vehicles to defrost. Please never leave your vehicle running unattended this is very dangerous and if it did get stolen it would probably not be insured.
