CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING FOXBOROUGH ROAD RADLEY

I am writing to inform you that Oxfordshire County Council will be carrying out carriageway resurfacing on Foxborough Road between the junctions of White's Lane and Stonhouse Crescent starting on Wednesday 28th June and completing on Friday 30th June.

The work will commence at 8.30am and barring any unforeseen circumstances, will finish by 4pm each day. There will be a signed diversion route using White's Lane and each end of the closure will be manned. Due to the nature of the work, vehicle movements will be severely restricted and it is therefore advised to move your vehicle outside of the working area should you wish to use it between the stated times. Full access will resume from approximately 4pm and overnight.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and staff will be present on site to assist you if required.

Day One – White's Lane to Gooseacre

The road surface will be removed and a base material will be laid. Works will start at the junction of White's Lane extending just past the junction with Gooseacre. Residents in this area needing to use their vehicles at any time between 8.30am and 4pm should park them out of the closure area.

Day Two – Gooseacre to Stonhouse Crescent

The road surface will be removed and a base material will be laid on the remaining section, between Gooseacre and Stonhouse Crescent. Therefore residents on this part of Foxborough Road and Badgers Copse will need to move their vehicles away from the area as above.

Day Three – White's Lane to Stonhouse Crescent

The new road surface will be laid along the whole section, beginning at White's Lane and moving back towards Stonhouse Crescent.

If you need to use your vehicle within the closure times, please speak with any of the staff members on site **before** attempting to drive out of your property or the side roads. In usual summer conditions the new surface can be driven on after approximately one hour, however if we see the return of the temperatures seen over the past week, this will be extended to two hours.

Until the new surface is laid the manhole and gully covers will be slightly raised from the surface, therefore please take care when driving and crossing the road.

I have liaised with Biffa and can confirm that the refuse collection will go ahead as planned. Please ensure your bins are outside your property by 7am.

Bus stops within the closure area will be suspended. On speaking with Oxford Bus Company they will attend all stops as far as Radley Station then turn into St James Terrace/St James Rd where they will place temporary bus stops. Notices explaining the temporary changes will be displayed on the affected bus stops.

I would like to apologise for any inconvenience that this work may cause and thank you for your patience and co-operation whilst it is taking place.
