6. The Internal auditor has reported a negative response to question M. Her explanation was that the period of public rights did not last for 30 days. "The period of Exercise of Public Rights starts 2 July 2020 and ends 14 August 2020 which is 32 days. The Council rejected this finding and agreed that it could answer "Yes" to item 4 of the Annual Governance Statement.

7. Reserves: Community Infrastructure Levy income from 2 major housing sites (C.500 new homes) in the parish is set aside to be aggregated for future and ongoing Neighbourhood Plan projects. Both CIL income and agreed projects have been delayed by the pandemic.

Village Hall and playing field/pavilion renovations and improvements, plans for a nature area in the parish, new community building on one of the housing sites currently in train.

The Council also holds reserves for future replacement of pieces of play equipment or renewal of the whole playground when necessary, future election expenses, possible legal expenses and replacement of I.T equipment. The annual front garden competition was not held in 2020 so a small grant given for that purpose has been set aside until the competition can be held.
